Olivia is going to be a 7th grader at PCMS. This is her eighth play. Her hobbies include cheerleading, plays, and track.



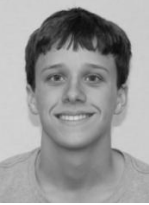

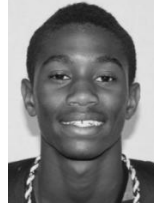

Javon gives a shout out to Noah James Donnell, his best friend... "Love you Big Dog # Bromode."



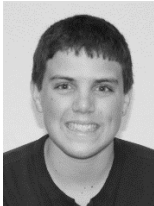
Keshawn Young – Seaweed

Adam will be a sophomore at PCHS. He has been involved in four productions. He is also involved with the swim team and high school soccer.



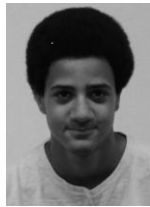
Shayna Smith – Makeup & Crew
